

Conference on Teachers' Professional Identities

First announcement

We are happy to invite the mathematics education research community and colleagues in related fields to a conference on teachers' professional identities on 9-10 November 2022 at Linnaeus University, Växjö Sweden.

We are happy that Einat Heid-Metzuyanin (Technion, Haifa, Israel¹) and Sonja Lutovac (University of Oulu, Finland²) have accepted our invitations to present at the conference. Both have made very important contributions to identity research in mathematics education.

Others are invited to submit an abstract of 300-500 words for a 30-minute presentation addressing one or more of the following:

- Conceptual and theoretical issues in research on teachers' of professional identities;
- Methodological challenges in research on teachers' professional identities;
- Empirical studies of the identity or identity development of prospective or practicing teachers (all educational levels);

To submit an abstract, send it as a pdf-file to Jeppe Skott (jeppe.skott@lnu.se) no later than 18 September 2022. Notification of acceptance will sent by 1 October 2022.

If you want to participate without presenting a paper, also send an e-mail to Jeppe Skott (jeppe.skott@lnu.se) no later than 18 September.

We do not arrange accommodation for the conference. It is convenient to stay at Teleborg Castle (<https://teleborgsslott.com/>), which is located right by the university campus. Another option is the Elite Stadshotellet (<https://elite.se/en/hotell/vaxjo/stadshotellet>) in the city centre from where you can reach the university by bus or a nice 3½ km. walk.

The cost of participation is 1500 s.kr., which covers lunch at the university cafeteria on 9 and 10 November, coffee during breaks and a conference dinner on the evening of the 9 November.

Växjö is easily reached by train. If you come from abroad, it is probably easiest to fly to Copenhagen. There is a direct train from Copenhagen Airport to Växjö.
